Our Community Fundraising Volunteers play an important role in helping us raise both funds and awareness within local communities. By supporting bucket collections in supermarkets and shopping centres, as well as attending local events such as fetes and fayres, you help generate vital donations while giving members of the public the opportunity to learn more about our work and why it matters. This role is ideal for someone who enjoys meeting people, representing the charity positively and making a real difference in a simple but meaningful way.

What You'll Do:

- Represent the charity at local community events such as summer and Christmas fairs, school fetes and other community gatherings, hosting awareness stands and engaging with the public.
- Support bucket collections in supermarkets, shopping centres and other appropriate public locations, helping to raise funds safely and responsibly.
- Handle donations collected during bucket collections in line with 2wish guidance, ensuring collection buckets are kept secure and returned as instructed.
- Help set up and clear down awareness stands, and occasionally support our merchandise stall, chatting to people about our work and the difference their support makes.

Shifts are typically 2–4 hours long and you will usually work alongside other volunteers, and occasionally alongside members of the 2wish staff team

What We're Looking For:

- A positive, approachable attitude and the ability to represent 2wish professionally.
- Confidence in speaking with supporters and families who visit your stand or stall.
